

What is a Major Unusual Incident (MUI)?


...Alleged, suspected, or actual occurrence of an incident that adversely affects the health and safety of an individual, including acts committed or allegedly committed by one individual against another individual.

The Ohio Department of DD mandates that the County Board MUI Investigative Agent reports and investigates all MUIs in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code.

Understanding Major Unusual Incidents is a key priority for persons with developmental disabilities, families, service providers, and employees of Allen County Board of DD.
