Ohio DB101.*

A common fear of jobseekers is losing benefits such as Medicaid or Social Security if they get a job. A useful resource that can ease this fear and help make an informed decision about working, is Ohio DB101.

DB stands for Disability Benefits and the website provides information and calculators to see how working may impact benefits.

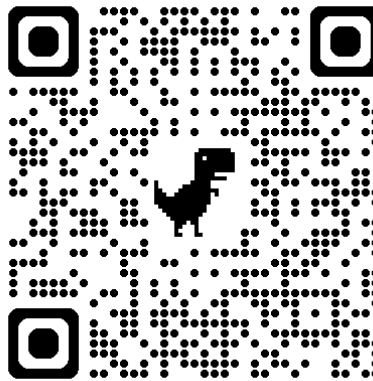
There is information about the different types of benefits such as SSI or SSDI as well as benefits programs that can help you be able to work. This includes STABLE and MBIWD (Medicaid Buy-In for Workers with Disabilities).

The website allows you to save your Estimator Sessions and favorite articles for future reference under the MyDB101 tab. There is also a glossary of terms as they relate to benefits, services, finances and employment.
